### Magdale Land

During the summer months its been pleasing to see the range of wildflowers on Magdale, and we are pleased that it was used as a venue for a wildflower Identification course. We continue to try to enhance the range of wildflowers by managing the area in a way that will encourage this outcome.

One of the our key tasks during the summer months is to manage the spread of Himalayan Balsam and this has been a major activity for two of our volunteer sessions. We will never eliminate it but our aim is to control and reduce this invasive plant as far as we can.






This year we had a stall in the Countryside Marquee at the Honley Show. A number of stalls for environmental groups, including ours, were funded by Natural Kirklees. There was a steady stream of people coming through the marquee and it was good to engage with them about our work on Magdale. We mocked up a bee bank and stuck wooden lollypop sticks in the sand, some of which had bees stuck on the end. This particularly attracted children and those who successfully chose a stick with a bee were rewarded with a packet of wildflower seeds.

We have a core group of volunteers but could do with more people to keep on top of our work in managing Magdale and Southgate Woods. 
